



Moovit and Rapid KL partner to provide locals in Kuala Lumpur with an easier commute

Now more than 8 million Klang Valley locals can use the Moovit app to plan multimodal journeys and view real-time bus arrival information, enabling them to travel with confidence

Kuala Lumpur - 26 August 2020 - [Moovit](#), an Intel-owned leading Mobility as a Service (MaaS) solutions company and the maker of the #1 urban mobility app, is announcing its partnership with Rapid KL to bring multimodal journey planning and real-time bus information to locals. Now, riders in Klang Valley have access to the most comprehensive urban mobility information in one app for the smoothest possible journey around Kuala Lumpur and surrounding areas.

Moovit's iOS, Android, and Web app is available for free to transport riders. Moovit combines official information from Rapid KL as well as crowdsourced information to calculate the best route for each journey with urban mobility options like MRT, LRT, KTM, ERL, monorail, and buses.

More than 126 million riders were recorded traveling in 2019 via Rapid KL's bus network. Thanks to this partnership with Moovit using real-time data from Rapid Bus Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary under Prasarana Malaysia Bhd, which operates Rapid KL buses, over 8 million citizens in the Klang Valley can now plan their journeys much more easily with the availability of live information covering Rapid KL, MRT Feeder & LRT Feeder, GO KL, and selected Smart Selangor bus routes; along with the locations of almost 7,500 designated bus stops at their fingertips.

Moovit provides users real-time arrival information so they know exactly when their bus or train is arriving, a Live Directions feature with Get Off Alerts to provide step-by-step guidance for the entire journey, and Service Alerts so they can avoid disruptions on usual routes and plan their journey accordingly. The Moovit app is also accessible-friendly, empowering people across the disability spectrum to use transport with more assurance. The app is optimized with screen reading features for low vision users, including TalkBack/VoiceOver capabilities, and identifies wheelchair-accessible routes and stations. Moovit's app is also designed with optimized menus and buttons for those with hand-motor disabilities.

In addition, Moovit is the first app to provide real-time arrival information on:

- KTM Komuter Regional Rail
- All Smart Selangor Routes, despite multiple agencies operating under Smart Selangor

"Moovit's mission is to simplify urban mobility, and since 2012 we have worked with thousands of transport agencies across 3,200 cities in 106 countries to make that a reality," said Samuel Sed Piazza, Moovit's Director of Partnerships, EMEA and APAC. "Together with Rapid KL, we
